

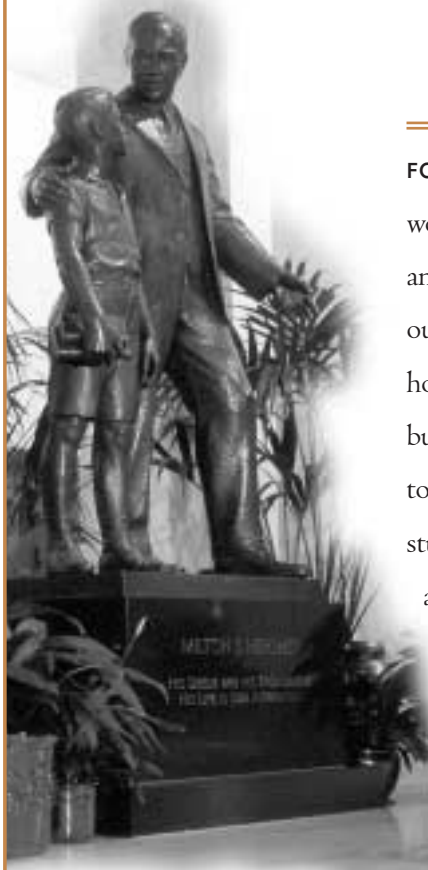

FOR MORE THAN 90 YEARS, the hard work and talents of our students and staff have brought honor to our School, our community, and our home. To ensure that these contributions receive recognition — and to serve as an inspiration to MHS students and staff of today and tomorrow — Milton Hershey School has established The Spartan Hall of Fame.

Why a Hall of Fame?

MHS graduates and staff serve as important role models for our students and we trust that the examples of achievement illustrated by the Spartan Hall of Fame members will:

- Inspire and motivate our students to excel in everything they do.
- Create a desire to emulate and surpass the accomplishments of past award recipients with the belief that this may help MHS students attain the highest level of value from their Milton Hershey School experience.
- Foster outstanding citizenship, fairness, honor, pride, and respect for themselves, their classmates and peers, and their School.
- Recognize and honor the great athletes, performing and visual artists, and related staff members who have brought fame to Milton Hershey School through their accomplishments while at Milton Hershey School.

Who can be nominated?

Candidates for membership in the Spartan Hall of Fame must be graduates of Milton Hershey School or current or retired staff members who meet the following requirements in athletics or the visual and performing arts. Posthumous nominations also may be submitted.

Criteria for all graduate nominees

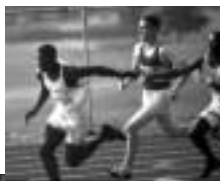
- A candidate is eligible for consideration during his/her fifth year after graduation from MHS.
- The candidate must have demonstrated good citizenship both while a student and after graduation from MHS.



ATHLETIC CRITERIA

The candidate must have achieved any of the following honors:

- Named to a high school All-America team
- Individual or team state championship
- National tournament championship
- Selected to the *Patriot News* all-league, all-district, all-area, or all-state team



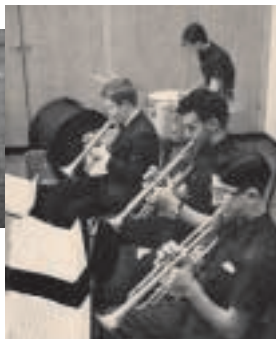
VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS CRITERIA

The candidate must have achieved any of the following honors:

- Selection to perform or have work performed or exhibited regionally, statewide, nationally, or internationally
- Recognition from a state, national, or international arts adjudication group
- Recognition from a government official or government agency for contributions to the arts or arts education
- Recognition as a significant contributor to the development/growth of the arts

CURRENT OR RETIRED STAFF CRITERIA

After 10 years of service, current or retired members of the Milton Hershey School staff who have demonstrated outstanding accomplishments to the development of MHS students' lives, through service to their respective programs, may be considered for induction.





How do I nominate someone?

Alumni and staff may submit nominations at any time during the year with Dec. 31 as the cut-off date for nominations for the following year (e.g. Dec. 31, 2003, for the 2004 induction).

How are winners selected?

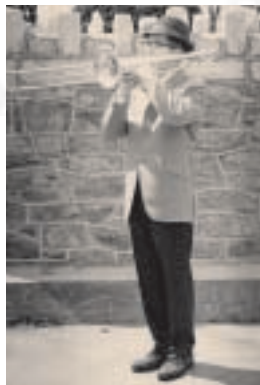
Nominations first will be evaluated by athletic and visual and performing arts subcommittees to ensure that nominees meet the nomination criteria. Qualified nominations will be reviewed by the Spartan Hall of Fame Steering Committee, which includes representatives from Graduate Services, the MHS Alumni Association, the High School, the Athletics Department, and Visual & Performing Arts staff. The Steering Committee will forward its recommendations to the Office of the President for final review and selection.

When will the winners be announced?

Each year at Homecoming, a special ceremony will be held to announce and induct the newest members into the Spartan Hall of Fame.
